### Introduction

The Department of Economics started functioning as soon as the University was established by transferring M.A. Economics classes from Government College, Bosan Road, Multan to the University. Teaching staff was also acquired on deputation from the same

institution. At present, there are ten members of the teaching staff. Four of them hold Ph.D. degrees from abroad and one from Pakistan.

The Department offers a wide range of courses in the field of Economics. In line with the decision of Higher Education Commission (HEC), the Department of Economics has introduced BS, 4 years program, from the academic session 2007-08. The main purpose of this program is to provide the essential knowledge and skills of Economics to the students. The program offers promising choice to the students in the selection of their career at intermediate level.

Keeping in view the present day requirements of the subject, the Department of Economics is already offering exciting and academically challenging postgraduate degree of M.A. Economics both in morning and in afternoon program (self-finance). The program provides a foundation in modern technique of Quantitative Economics, Financial Economics and Econometrics with emphasis on quantitative tools such as Mathematics, Statistics and Computer applications. The central feature of the course is its blend of core economic concepts and principles with modern research methods. Masters of Arts in Economics is a two years postgraduate program based on annual system.

The Department also aims at promoting research on various local and national issues. For this purpose the Department has introduced both M.Phil. and Ph.D. programs. Presently, twenty students have been registered as Ph.D. candidates. The students strength has now risen to over 300 per academic year.

The Department has a library of more than 5000 books, plus a collection of national and international journals. Computer facilities are also available in the Department. As a bilateral exchange program, the Department has established a linkage with the Molde University College, Molde, Norway. Accordingly, the Molde University College will offer one scholarship for Doctoral Degree Program each year. Presently, three faculty members of this department are studying in Norway under the said program.

- i. Aggregate marks of BA/B.Sc. plus marks of Elective Economics plus 20 marks each for Statistics and Mathematics studied at BA/ B.Sc or F.A/F.Sc. level plus 20 marks for Hifz-e-Quran.
- ii. Aggregate marks obtained in B.Com plus marks of Economics studied in B.Com Plus 20 marks for Hifz-e-Quran.

### Introduction

The Department of Education was established in September, 1986, with the major purpose to produce competent, enlightened and well-disciplined teachers at the Master's level, i.e. M.A. Education and M.Ed. for both Arts and science students.

Initially, the Department started with four teachers. The staff strength has now grown to twelve. Out of these, four hold Ph.D. degree. The initial enrolment in M.A. Education and M.Ed., was 48 students which has at present gone upto 250. The services of foreign experts and renowned educationists are also secured from time to time with a view to improving and updating the quality of teaching/learning process. The library of the Department is adequately equipped with relevant text books and reference literature. The department also houses two science laboratories fully equipped with relevant material and one computer laboratory having 35 P-IV systems connected with the university local area network. The purpose of the computer laboratory is not only to provide the basic computer training to the students but also to meet the requirements of different research programs and projects of the department.

## Program of Study

### i) M.A. Education (Morning & Evening)

MA Education is a two year professional degree program. The main purpose of this program is to produce well trained teachers for schools including the Elementary and Secondary levels. However, the degree holders of MA Education can also join Colleges, Universities as Lecturer. In addition, they are eligible to be subject specialists at higher secondary schools. The program offers a wide range of courses regarding knowledge and skills essentially required for an effective and efficient teacher training program.

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## Scheme of Studies Available with the Department

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### Admission Criteria:

The merit will be determined as under:

- a. For Arts applicants with combination of Education.

Marks obtained in B.A.+10 marks for the subject of Education at B.A. level+20 marks for Hifz-e-Quran.

- b. For Arts applicants with all other combinations.

Marks obtained in B.A.+20 marks for Hifz-e-Quran.

- c. For Science Students.

Marks obtained in B.Sc. + 20 marks for Hifz-e-Quran.

## v) M.Phil.

M.Phil is a research based postgraduate program offered to Master Degree holders i.e. M.A.Education / M.Ed. The program is run under semester system with a total duration of four semesters (two years). First two semesters comprise thought course work and the last two are fixed for thesis.

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## Scheme of Studies Available with the Department

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### Admission Criteria

The entry requirement for this research degree program is master degree in Education (M.A.Education and M.Ed. with at least 45% marks) under the Annual System and 50% marks under Semester System. The other details are the same as prescribed by the university.

## vi) Ph.D.

Ph.D. is a research based postgraduate programme offered to students with M.Phil/ M.S. degree. The programme has two parts comprising course work of 18 credit hours (two semesters) following by a research thesis which is to be completed within the time limit as prescribed by the university. For the fulfillment of degree requirements, all the formalities are to be completed as per the standard laid down by the university.

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### Admission Criteria

The entry requirements for Ph.D. is M.Phil/ MS with at least CGPA 3.00 under semester system or equivalent as per the university criteria. The other details are the same as prescribed by the university given under general rules and regulations available in the prospectus.

### Introduction

The Department of History was established in 1976, a year after the establishment of the university. Initially, the Department started functioning in a rented building in Gulgasht Colony, Multan. In 1980, it was shifted to Languages Block (IOL) and finally in 1986 to its own building, the History and Political Science Block at the university campus. Department of History started a diploma program in Pakistan Studies which was later on upgraded to a regular M.A. Pakistan Studies program in 1986. The program of M.Phil. in History has also been started from spring 1997 while Ph.D program was also initiated from its beginning and the department enrolled Ph.D

students. A number of scholars have been received their Ph.D degrees from this department and many other scholars are working on their Ph.D projects. Regular course work for Ph.D is also going on.

The department came into existence with a staff of three regular lecturers, one research scholar and one part time teacher. At present, the Department has the services of six regular teachers including three Ph.Ds., two M.Phil. degree holder and one Master degree holder.

As many disciplines have been established at university campus, the university has decided to take further step by establishing Geography department and offering M.Sc. Geography degree program.

Geography is a science, that deals with the distributive phenomena on the face of earth which effect the knowledge of our environment and nature around us that is certainly essential for our development, better life conditions and progress. Geography provides such knowledge and skills that contribute in the process of making an abler and highly developed human society. It is an enquiry, a study of the causes and an attempt to find out why and how natural surroundings and geographical features influence the life of man on this planet. Diversity and richness in landforms, climate vegetation, animals, deserts and other natural features of South Punjab indicate the fact that a science like Geography must have its roots in this region that will certainly help the people of this region to develop their skills in Geography and contribute in the development of whole nation.

### The main objectives of this M.Sc. Geography Program are:

1. Development of Human Resources in South Punjab
2. To provide the people of this region with a facility to learn and research in the filed of Geography.
3. To promote Geography as a practical tool helpful in the understanding of relationship between a man and nature.
4. Availability of Post –Graduate level studies in Geography so that students of all economic stratum can easily get their aspired higher education.
5. To explore the Geographical diversity of this area and to deliver the country with more research and education in Geography.

### Degree Requirement

These are the essential requirements for the degree of M.Sc in Geography.

- i. The M.Sc. Geography will be two years program.
- ii. Successful completion of 19 courses individually carrying 3 credit hours each and with 6 credit hours thesis ( in lieu of two courses)
- iii. Securing a minimum CGPA of 2.20 for completion of the program.
- iv. Completion of 2-4 weeks internship in an industrial/business/ commercial organizations.
- v. Passing comprehensive examination on completion of course work.

### Eligibility

The Candidates who have passed B.A./B.Sc., B.B.A., B.Com., BCS (or equivalent examination) securing at least 45% marks in aggregate shall be eligible in M.Sc. Geography Part-I.

### Computation of Merit

- i. Aggregate marks in B.A./B.Sc. B.B.A., B.Com., BCS (or equivalent examination) plus twenty (20) marks for Hafiz-e-Quran.
- ii. Preference will be given to those who hold Geography as an elective subject at B.A./B.Sc. level.

### Introduction

The Department of Pakistan Studies came into existence as a result of bifurcation of the Department of History and Pakistan Studies on 4th June 1998. The Department of History and Pakistan Studies was established in 1976. Initially a diploma course in Pakistan Studies was introduced which was up-graded into M.A. Programme in 1987.

The subject of Pakistan Studies is interdisciplinary and encompasses various aspects of Pakistan's history and culture. The main purpose of M.A. in Pakistan Studies is to provide an in-depth understanding of Pakistan. The Programme therefore offers courses consisting of History, Political Science, Geography, Economics, Foreign Relations, Sociology and Literature of Pakistan. The Department offers teaching and research facilities for M.A, M.Phil and Ph.D. Scholars.

To cater the needs of the area of southern Punjab, a Master Program in Gender Studies has been launched by the Department of Pakistan Studies in 2008 which offers the opportunity to learn more about gender-based knowledge particularly with the reference to the social issues of this region.

### Admission

The detail of seats each for admission to M.A. Pakistan Studies and Gender Studies is given in Chart No.1. The Departmental Admission Committee, according to the admission/merit criteria laid down by the Department, will make the admission to M.A. part-I under annual System and MA Gender Studies under Semester System respectively.

### Eligibility for M.A. in Pakistan Studies.

- i) Admission in the M.A. Pakistan Studies will be granted to the application on the basis of their B.A./BSc. results and performance in admission test (if notified in the prospectus).
- ii) Applicants must be a Graduate with a minimum of second division, (45% marks) from a recognized university to be eligible for the admission in M.A. Pakistan Studies Program. Twenty marks will be included for *Hifza-e-Quran*. The age limit will be 26 years. There shall be no discrimination on the basis of sex, creed, religion and region.

### Computation of Merit

The merit will be determined on the basis of aggregate marks secured in B.A./BSc. examination. However ten (10) additional marks (per

elective subject) will be added for subjects, i.e. Pakistan Studies, History, Political Science, Economics, Geography, Sociology and Philosophy, plus twenty marks for Hafiz-Quran.

- ii) All the candidates having the qualifications or Master Degree in the relevant subject with at least 2<sup>nd</sup> Division i.e. 45% marks or C-Grade with 50% marks under semester system shall be eligible to apply for admission to M.Phil class.
- iii) There shall be no discrimination on the basis of sex, creed, religion or region.
- iv) A test equivalent to GRE/GMAT in the relevant subject securing at least 50% marks; academic qualification 40%; and

publication 10% will be counted for admission to M.Phil.

- v) Admission of all students will be provisional and subject to the final approval by the Bahauddin Zakariya University, Multan.
- vi) The Vice-Chancellor, the Dean, or the Chairman of the Department may refuse admission to any candidate without assigning any reason.
- vii) The Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the chairman/ director/Principal of the Department/ Centre/Institute/College shall constitute the admission committee for each Department.
- viii) Candidates whose names were dropped or struck off the rules of M.Phil or equivalent program of any department due to shortage of lectures or non-payment of dues or poor performance or non—appearance (without prior permission) in examination etc. shall not be granted admission without the permission of the Syndicate.
- ix) Maximum upper age limit seeking admission to M.Phil program in shall be forty-five years on the last date fixed for receipt of applications.

- iii) No student shall get admission in any other degree program anywhere during his/her enrolment as Ph.D. student.
- iv) The candidate offered admission would be required to submit affidavit on a stamp paper of Rs.20/-duly attested by the Oath commissioner/Gazetted Officer, that he/she has not taken admission in any other Department or course.
- v) In-service students shall submit NOC from their employers at the time of registration.

## Introduction

The Department came into existence when M.A. Political Science classes, being held at the Government College, Multan since 1963, were shifted to the Bahauddin Zakariya University (then University of Multan) in 1975. The Department started functioning in a rented building in Gulgasht Colony, Multan. In 1980, it moved to the Language Block (IOL) and finally to its present building in 1986.

In the beginning, the Department had a strength of 35 students and three staff members, borrowed from Government College, Multan. At present, there are ten staff members among whom five hold Ph.D.s, two M.Phil. Degree, and one is working on a research project leading to Ph.D. The Department provides teaching and research facilities at M.A., M.Phil and Ph.D. levels. Information regarding Ph.D. programme can be had from the Chairman of the Department. The Department has been progressively enhancing its research activities. At present, 24 scholars have been registered for Ph.D. degree.

In addition to M.A. Political Science, the Department is successfully running an evening program of Master's Degree in International Relations on self-finance basis. M.Phil in Political Science was also launched on regular basis in 2001.

The library of the Department is well equipped. There are five thousand books in the library containing modern and old manuscripts. A sizable number of Research Journals is also available to cater to the needs of the students, teachers and researchers. The students are also encouraged to go on study tours of historical places/institutions as part of their studies for M.A. degree.

### Introduction

The Department of Mass Communication came into being with the bifurcation of the Department of Political Science and Mass Communication on 15.12.1996. Previously in its old shape the Department was pursuing an evening program of diploma course in Mass Communication since 1987, which was upgraded to Master's level in 1991, fulfilling the desire and demand of the people of the region. At present, the regular teaching staff for Mass

Communication consists of one Professor, one Associate Professor and one Assistant Professor and eight lecturers holding Master's degree in the subject of Mass Communication and also research scholars of Ph.D.

The Department provides teaching and research facilities at M.A., M.Phil and Ph.D. levels. Information regarding Ph.D. programme may be taken from the office of the Department. The Department is progressively enhancing its research activities. At present two scholars have been registered for Ph.D. degree and four scholars have already completed their Ph.D. from the Department. The purpose envisaged of M.A. Mass Communication programme is to introduce positive values to the media and to equip young people with the latest knowledge and skills so that they enter into the profession of Mass Communication (Journalism) to play their effective role in national reconstruction and development.

### Evening Class of M.A. Mass Communication

Since 1996 evening classes of M.A. Part-I & II of Mass Communication have been started, which are functioning successfully.

### Media Labs for professional Training

The most illustrious aspect of the Department of Mass Communication is its professional and proficient training labs outfitted with state of the art contemporary gear. These labs comprise FM Radio, TV Studio, Advertising Lab and IT Lab. The prime objective of these labs is to provide latest professional acquaintance and wealth of practical orientation to the students of the Department of Mass Communication, so that they may get a better chance of employment in their particular field.

### FM Radio Station 104.6

The Department has established an FM radio station as "FM 104.6" for broadcast training of the students. Radio Station comprises of On air Studio, Production Studio, Student's Training Booths, Control Room, Digital Recording System and Editing System. It is established with the financial assistance offered by HEC. FM Radio Station is fully operative and providing training to the students. Programs on various issues related to the university, education, agriculture and religion are being broadcast on daily basis. All programmes are planned, produced and presented by the University students.

### TV Production House

TV Studio is an added aspect of the Department which makes the Department of Mass Communication of BZU one of the most sophisticated and technologically well equipped department in the list of Mass Communication Departments of Pakistan. TV Studio production is also on track. It is a close circuit T.V network and all programmes are produced by the Department's students. T.V. News Bulletin and documentaries production is a part of their practical learning. At the outset the students are preparing programs of news & current affairs. The first and foremost objective of TV Studio is to lend a hand to the students for practical training in electronic journalism. The Department has also plans for offering training courses in film production in future.

### Advertising Lab

The Advertising Lab of the Department has all the facilities obligatory for training in the field of advertisement production. The students learn about the editing process and shooting the ads alongwith all the minor details necessary for making of advertisements for print and electronic media.

### IT Lab

Department is also offering the courses about computer education. To meet the requirements of the 21<sup>st</sup> century, computer education is mandatory. The Department understands the need of the hour that is why a latest computer lab is established where 30 work stations are available for the students.

### Departmental Newspaper and Magazine
